


The Martin Mauler—Rare ARF Model—It was the main competitor to the Douglas AD Skyraider. Designed to be a single engine multi-purpose attack aircraft capable of handling dive bombing, scouting, and torpedo missions. It entered service in 1948 and served until 1953. It was larger than the Skyraider and could carry more payload. It has the record for carrying the heaviest payload of any single-engine piston-powered aircraft. 10648 lbs of armament. According to Wikipedia there is a Maurader in storage at Planes of Fame in Chino and an airframe in good condition Naval Aviation Museum in Florida—Presented by Jon Perry


